

Walkies!

Meet at Swineford picnic site car park (directions below)

Invite your family, friends and pets to come and join us on a lovely 5.5km circular walk (2 to 3 hours at a gentle pace) from Swineford along the banks of the River Avon, up the Bristol and Bath railway path, across the fields to Bitton village and on to Swineford.

Tea, coffee and biscuits will be available at the end of the walk.

Unfortunately the walk is not suitable for pushchairs or toddlers. Some of the paths, particularly at the end of the walk can get really muddy, so bring your wellies. Please keep an eye on children since we have to cross the road in a couple of locations and as we walk alongside the River Avon.

Directions to the start of the walk (about half an hour from Downend)

1. Travel south along the A4174 Ring Road.
2. Turn left off the ring road at Longwell Green
3. Take the second junction off the next roundabout
4. Turn left at the next roundabout along the A431 towards Bitton
5. Drive through Bitton
6. Turn off the A431 at the Swan Inn, Swineford
7. Follow the track past the Swan Inn car park
8. Park at the Swineford picnic site
