



Read the Bible Together (RBT)

What is it?

Over the next several years (beginning February 2019) we are planning to read through the whole of the Bible as a Church. It's open to members and non-members to participate, and people can join in at any point even if they've missed the start.

Each month we will start with an *RBT Overview* sermon, designed to help prepare us for the book we will read that month. You will now have the rest of that month to read that book of the Bible through in your own time. Eight questions are asked of every book every month, and we'll meet in small groups to discuss what we have read and learned. We will follow the same pattern every month.

Helpful Hints

- If you don't find reading easy, then get an audio version of the Bible (via a CD, Mp3, online of Bible App) and listen along.
- Always pray before you read through the passage, asking the Holy Spirit for help.
- Write down your answers and insights to help you remember them, so as to make the discussion group that much more fruitful!
- If you fall behind with the reading, you won't be the only one! Don't worry or be discouraged. You can start fresh next month.
- If you've not managed to complete the set reading please still come along to the discussion groups — being there will encourage you and others!
- Can you babysit for someone/another couple so both husband and wife can go to the discussion group together?
